

Bible Memory: August

***God is Almighty - Jeremiah 32:17-19 (NIV, 1984)**

¹⁷ “Ah, Sovereign Lord, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

¹⁸ You show love to thousands but bring the punishment for the fathers' sins into the laps of their children after them. O great and powerful God, whose name is the LORD Almighty,

¹⁹ great are your purposes and mighty are your deeds. Your eyes are open to all the ways of men; you reward everyone according to his conduct and as his deeds deserve.

***God is the Blessing-Giver – Malachi 3:10 (NIV, 1984)**

¹⁰ Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it.

***God is our Creator – Revelation 4:11 (ESV)**

¹¹ “Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created.”

Bible Memory: September

***God is our Deliverer – Psalm 18:2 (ESV)**

² The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

***God is Eternal – Jeremiah 10:10 (NIV, 1984)**

¹⁰ But the LORD is the true God; he is the living God, the eternal King. When he is angry, the earth trembles; the nations cannot endure his wrath.

***God is our Father – 2 Corinthians 6:18 (ESV)**

¹⁸ and I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me, says the Lord Almighty.”

***God is Gracious – Psalm 145:8-9 (ESV)**

⁸ The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

⁹ The Lord is good to all, and his mercy is over all that he has made.

Bible Memory: October

***God is Holy – Psalm 77:13 (ESV)**

¹³ Your way, O God, is holy. What god is great like our God?

***God is Incomparable – Isaiah 40:25 (NIV, 1984)**

²⁵ "To whom will you compare me? Or who is my equal?" says the Holy One.

***God is the Just Judge – Psalm 98:8-9 (ESV)**

⁸ Let the rivers clap their hands; let the hills sing for joy together
⁹ before the Lord, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity.

***God is our King – Psalm 47:2 (NIV, 1984)**

² How awesome is the LORD Most High, the great King over all the earth!

***God is Love – 1 John 4:16 (ESV)**

¹⁶ So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him

Bible Memory: November

***God is Merciful – Daniel 9:9 (NIV, 1984)**

9 The Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled against him.

Psalm 90:1-2 (ESV)

¹ Lord, you have been our dwelling place
in all generations.

² Before the mountains were brought forth,
or ever you had formed the earth and the world,
from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

***God is Near – Psalm 119:151 (ESV)**

¹⁵¹ But you are near, O LORD, and all your commandments are true.

Bible Memory: December

*** God is Omniscient – Hebrews 4:13 (NIV, 1984)**

¹³ Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

***God is our Provider – Philippians 4:19 (ESV)**

¹⁹ And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Bible Memory: January

*** God is found in Quietness – Lamentation 3:25-26 (ESV)**

²⁵ The Lord is good to those who wait for him, to the soul who seeks him.

²⁶ It is good that one should wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord.

*** God is our Refuge – Psalm 46:1 (ESV)**

¹ God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

*** God is Sovereign – Psalm 103:19 (ESV)**

¹⁹ The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.

Christian Heritage – Hebrews 12:1 (ESV)

¹ Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us.

Bible Memory: February

*** Missions Month**

Declare God's glory – 1 Chronicles 16:23-28 (ESV)

23 Sing to the LORD, all the earth! Tell of his salvation from day to day.

24 Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!

25 For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, and he is to be feared above all gods.

26 For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols, but the LORD made the heavens.

27 Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his place.

28 Ascribe to the LORD, O families of the peoples, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength!

Bible Memory: March

Preparation for the Resurrection Trail

Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life – John 11:25-26 (ESV)

²⁵ Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live,

²⁶ and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?”

***God is True – 1 John 5:20 (ESV)**

²⁰ And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true; and we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.

***God is Unchangeable – James 1:16-17 (NIV, 1984)**

¹⁶ Don't be deceived, my dear brothers.

¹⁷ Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

Bible Memory: April

***God is Victorious – 1 Corinthians 15:17 (ESV)**

¹⁷ But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

***God is Wise – Romans 11:33 (ESV)**

³³ Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!

***God is (e)Xalted – Psalm 57:5 (ESV)**

⁵ Be exalted, O God, above the heavens! Let your glory be over all the earth!

God's wondrous deeds, might, and power to another generation – Psalm 71: 17-18 (ESV)

¹⁷ O God, from my youth you have taught me, and I still proclaim your wondrous deeds.

¹⁸ So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim your might to another generation, your power to all those to come.

Bible Memory: May

***God is Yahweh – Exodus 3:14-15 (ESV)**

¹⁴ God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And he said, “Say this to the people of Israel: ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”

¹⁵ God also said to Moses, “Say this to the people of Israel: ‘The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.’ This is my name forever, and thus I am to be remembered throughout all generations.

***God is Zealous – Isaiah 9:7 (NIV, 1984)**

⁷ Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David’s throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.
