

Summer of Success

A plan to help a student who has completed kindergarten be well prepared for first grade

Five days each week do the following:

- Review basic phonograms with Phonics Flash Cards
- Review Sight Word cards
- Have your child draw a picture and write in cursive a sentence about it, making sure there is a capital letter at the beginning, punctuation at the end, spacing between words. Please do not stress about spelling, just write the correct spelling above the misspelled word and praise your child for their accomplishments.
- Have child read regularly from the following books (or books similar to these***):
